30 DAY RETREAT

26 June – 30th July 2019

The Ignatian Spirituality Centre in Glasgow offers the full Spiritual Exercises of St Ignatius Loyola in the *Centro de Espiritualidad*, Loyola, Spain. The retreat is silent and individually guided with a daily Eucharist in English.

The Spirituality Centre in Loyola is spacious and newly refurbished with numerous chapels and prayer spaces, shaded indoor walkways and quiet, extensive private gardens. Bedrooms are single with en-suite facilities. Full-board catering with fresh Spanish cuisine. The Centre is linked by private walkway to the ancient family house of St Ignatius himself. Upon arrival there will be guided tours of the local sites associated with the life of St Ignatius

Loyola is surrounded by beautiful hills, with the river Urola running by the house; a good place for walking.

July in Loyola is warm, but without the heat of a Mediterranean summer.

Suggested donation for the retreat is in Euro: €2,295 Which at March 2018 rate of exchange is £2,130. *Sterling prices may go up or down dependant upon the exchange rate.*

IGNATIAN SPAIN – A PILGRIMAGE

27 July – 3 August 2019



St Ignatius of Loyola:

Get to know the man, his times and his Spain.

The story of the life of Ignatius will be told as we follow in his footsteps. Daily Mass will be celebrated in the holy sites.

Pilgrims begin with three nights and two full days in Loyola, the place of Ignatius' birth. Where we visit the house of his birth and the chapel of his conversion and many other sights in this beautiful green part of Basque Spain.

We travel across Spain visiting Pamplona where Ignatius was struck by the fateful cannonball.

We then travel on to Montserrat and spend four nights in the 16th Century Abbot Cisneros Hotel in Montserrat.

We have a full day in Montserrat, a day in Manresa and a final day in the city of Barcelona seeing the sites associated with the life of Saint Ignatius. There will be some time for private sightseeing

Pilgrimage cost is €750 (single room supplement €70)
Which at March 2018 = £695 + supplement of £65
£1 = €1.08

Cost includes airport transfers, overland transport, 4 days half-board and 3 days full-board accommodation, and entrance fees.

For participants on the 30-day Spiritual Exercises the additional cost is €500 (single room supplement €40). *Which at March 2018 = £465 + supplement of £37 @ £1 = €1.08*

Sterling prices may go up or down dependant upon exchange rate.

Travel to Spain is not included in the cost. Guidance will be given as to the best flights to book from the UK and Ireland.
