Making Payments to the ISC from Outside UK

There are a number of methods of sending us funds, <u>please read the following carefully</u> and choose the best option for you.

We usually recommend that people sending money to us from a non UK bank overseas use a service called Wise

If you are resident in USA, Europe, New Zealand or Australia, or Canada then you can pay funds into a bank we hold in your region *in your own local currency*:
