## Team Member with Responsibility for Development and Outreach

We are looking for a development and outreach coordinator to develop the work of the ISC in Glasgow. We are currently looking at developing new ways of using the Centre and at working in partnership with other groups and organisations. We are also looking at expanding our outreach work to parishes, churches and schools and to marginalised groups. A particular focus in the next two years is to offer retreats and material to contribute to the "symphony of prayer" the Pope has asked for in preparation for the Holy Year in 2025. The role of the development and outreach coordinator would be to develop with the ISC Team and Associates this and other new initiatives.

**Hours**: 35 hours per week (full time) Flexibility is essential and there will be a requirement for some evening and weekend work.


We are open to full time, term time only or part time working arrangements.
